

Welcome to the Brattleboro Music Center Music School! Below is some general information about registering. Full information can be found at www.bmcvt.org/music-school.

Class Registrations: Please call to confirm class offerings. With the current pandemic situation, plans change, sometimes faster than we can keep the website updated!

Lesson Registrations:

The BMC asks students and faculty to consult each other directly to arrange lesson schedules. You and your teacher determine the day, time, length of lesson and how many lessons to have over the course of the official 16 week semester. **You are responsible for submitting this information to the BMC office.**

- Don't have an assigned teacher yet? Contact the BMC office for placement: 802.257.4523
- Contact your teacher and set up a day and time for your lessons. (Call the office if you need a phone number or email for your teacher.)
- Please confirm the day and time of your lessons and the date of the first lesson, how many lessons are planned for the semester and how long each lesson will be. Any deviation from the standard semester must be discussed with your teacher.
- Fill out the registration form and return it to the BMC with your initial payment.
- Signing up for lessons is a commitment. You are responsible for all lessons for which you have registered. Please review the make-up/cancellation policy in our handbook.

Payment:

2020 lesson tuition: Registration fee: \$16.00 per registration per semester

20 minute lesson \$368/semester (\$23.00/lesson)

45 minute lesson \$688/semester (\$43.00/lesson)

30 minute lesson \$528/semester (33.00/lesson)

60 minute lesson \$848/semester (\$53.00/lesson)

- Tuition is based on a 16 week semester. If a shorter commitment is agreed upon, the semester fee is prorated accordingly.
 - Summer "semester" is based entirely on the teacher/student schedule of lessons.
- A variety of payment plans are available but we ask that payment for at least the first four(4) lessons and registration fee be paid at the beginning of the semester. (See below if you are applying for financial aid).
- We are happy to work with you if unexpected situations arise – please just get in touch with the office.
- Please remember: teachers are under no obligation to teach lessons for which you have not paid and nonpayment may result in the suspension of lessons until you can get caught up.

Financial Aid: To apply for financial aid, please submit registration information, a financial aid application, \$16 registration fee **and payment for one lesson**. Awards are made at the beginning of the semester or as you apply. Please note that financial aid is available to any BMC student.
